## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE Larry Crosbie

Thanks to Ron Best, his committee volunteers and survey respondents for all the contributions toward the outline of Club Activities developed on Saturday, January 12. You will shortly see the tentative activities list on our website. We intend that you will have more activity choices to participate this year in weekly, monthly and one of a kind Club activities and outings.

We have an important opportunity to discuss in our February 2 monthly Club meeting. The Museum recently announced a unique way for clubs to donate. For \$3000 CLBG can purchase and decorate a table in the NCM Café to promote Corvettes Limited of Bowling Green. That table will stay in the Café for three years, then, it becomes the property of our Club. The Museum has agreed to consider our donation this month of \$1500 to be a 50% down payment on a table. We get full credit for a \$3000 total donation, plus we gain a table right now to help market our Club to local NCM guests and members. If the Board agrees to pursue this idea we will bring the idea before the membership next month for discussion and a motion to commit remaining funds to the Museum.
