



<u>NCM CEO...</u> As many of you already know, Dr. Sean Preston has departed as the NCM Chief Executive Officer. Jack Matukas (long time CLBG member) is currently filling in as interim CEO while a search for a permanent replacement takes place. With all of the exciting future plans in place for the museum, hopefully the position will be filled soon with someone to help with the museum's forward progress.

R8C Museum delivery – very popular... It no secret that the production of the 2020 C8 was hampered by several factors. The final number of Corvettes that were produced amounted to a little over 20,000. Interestingly, 943 of those or 4.6% were delivered off the floor of the National Corvette Museum. That number compares to 587 or 1.7% of the 2019 Corvettes that were delivered via museum delivery. If you wanted to play with those numbers a little farther, considere that the percentage is based on total number manufactured. However, approximately 8,500 2020 Corvettes were sold and delivered outside of the U.S.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH!

Cherry Chocolates



What says Valentine's Day more than candy — especially chocolates? Inspired by the Bourbon Balls from a previous recipe, I mused about how I might make a cherry filling. Excuse me while I pat myself on my back, but what I came up with is exactly what I had in mind. They are delicious, packed with bright cherry taste and as easy to make as the bourbon balls.



Filling:

1 pound confectioner's sugar

½ cup butter

2 cups whole tart frozen cherries, thawed, drained (reserve the juice) and finely chopped

1 tsp almond extract

¼ cup cherry juice

I use the frozen tart cherries. You need to prepare them ahead of time. I took two cups of the whole frozen cherries, completely thawed them, and drained them thoroughly, reserving all of the juice. Once the cherries are drained, chop them into very small bits.

Thoroughly blend the sugar, butter, almond extract and cherry juice. Stir in the cherries. Chill the mixture until firm, and shape into 3/4-inch balls. Chill again before dipping.

Chocolate coating:

Use a commercial chocolate coating. I recommend Ghirardelli's Dark Melting Wafers (Sam's Club!). It is easy to work with and very tasty.
